## **Section Details**

Leaving Drumhanbo follow the road north up Convent Avenue. Passing the church on your right take the next turn left on to the local road and continue north. There are fine views west to Lough Allen and Corrie Mountain along this stretch. In approx 6km you will cross the Stony River on a metal footbridge and continue north along local road. After 2km you will reach a car park where you will have completed this section of The Leitrim Way. There is a fine example of a sweathouse, located approx 300m to the east and is well worth a visit. It is thought that sweathouses were an early form of sauna used in the late 18th and 19th century.
